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Practice I

- + in the simplest case, a camera is set up which captures the action on stage

Practice I

Streaming as an additional source of information and to achieve a wider reach.

- + Economical, ecological from the organiser's point of view
- + Can be flexibly integrated into everyday life from the participants' point of view
- + Good cost-benefit ratio
